Brave visitors may even encounter **Krampus** and **Mari Lwyd** representing Germanic and Welsh holiday traditions.

“The Celtic Winter Faire has always been built around the feeling of stepping through a portal into another world,” said Ben Kerr, Event Director of Fae Festivals. “This year, that portal is opening wider. Expanding to three weekends gives guests more time to explore, return, and experience the Faire in a deeper way.”
